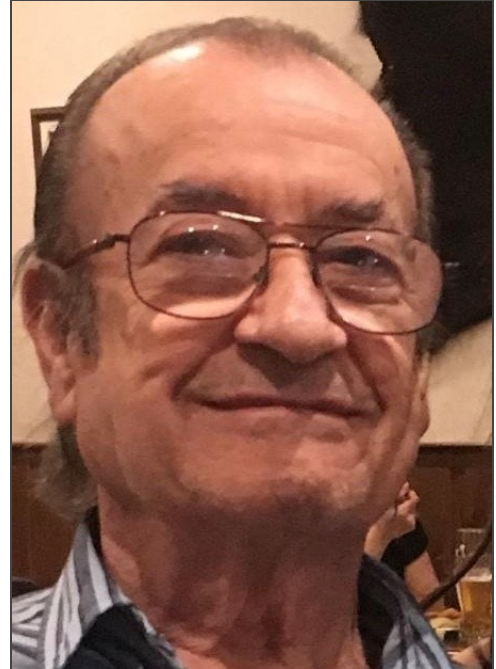


# Sarkis Gulvartian
