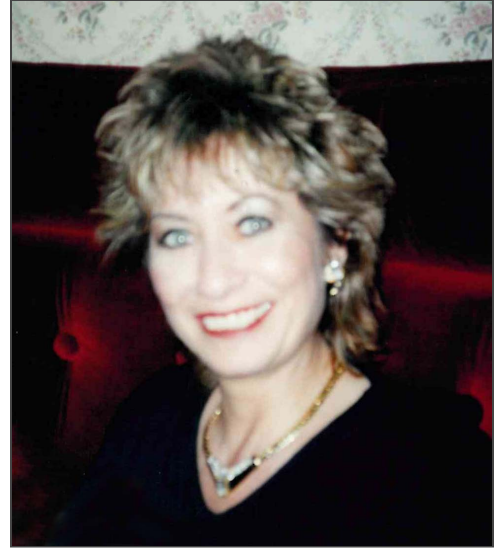


Maureen Lynn Gwilliam
