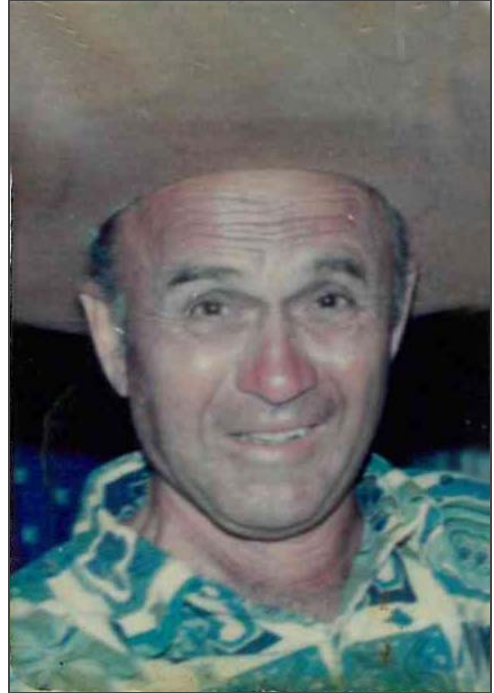


Andrew "Andy" Halapatz
