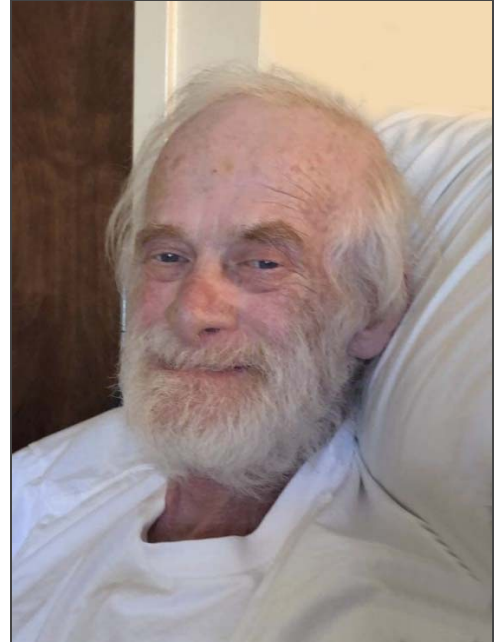


# Donn Stewart Hale
