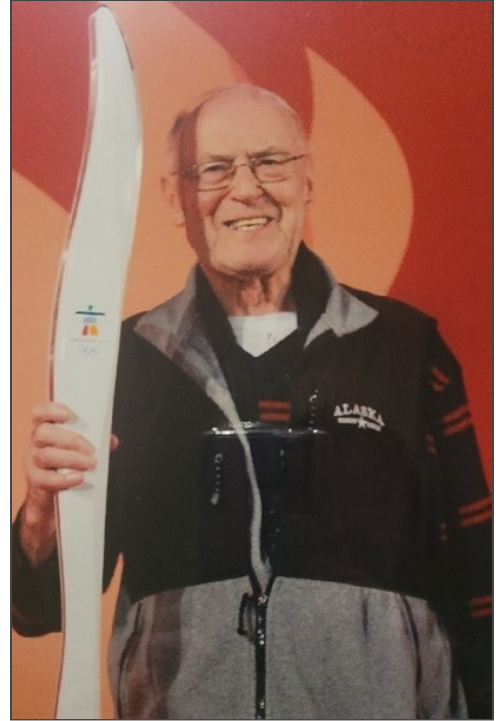
Born again 1945
