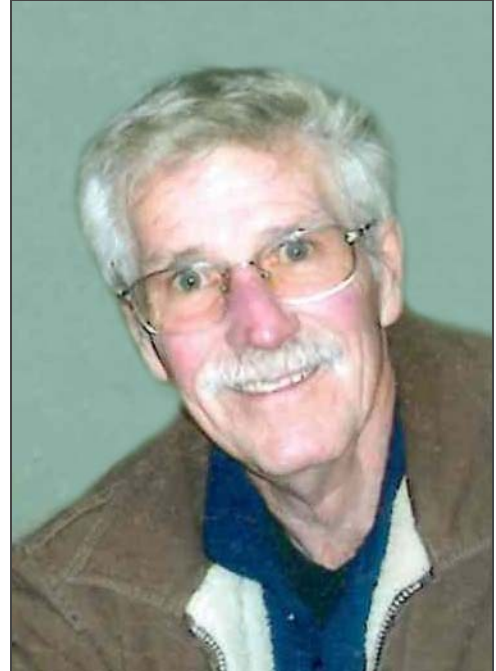


Roy Harcourt
