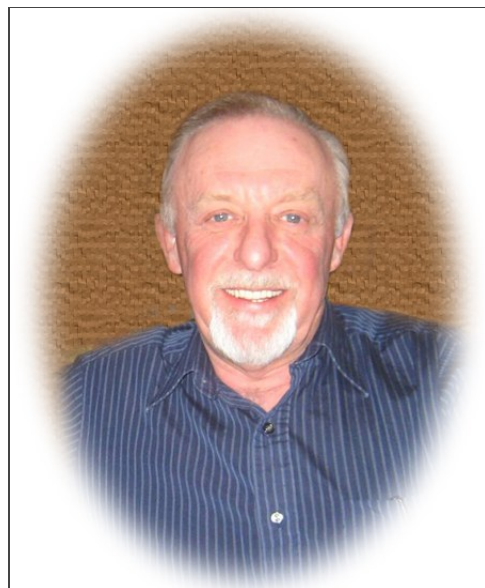


Jerry Hubert Edmund Harriman
