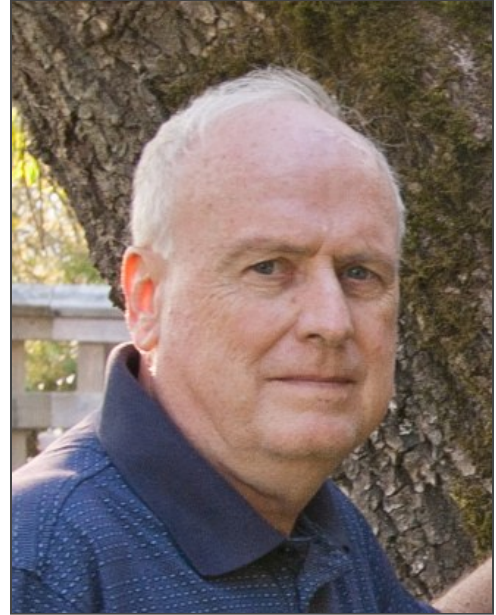


Robert (Bob) Clifford Harris
