

Merle Henry Harth

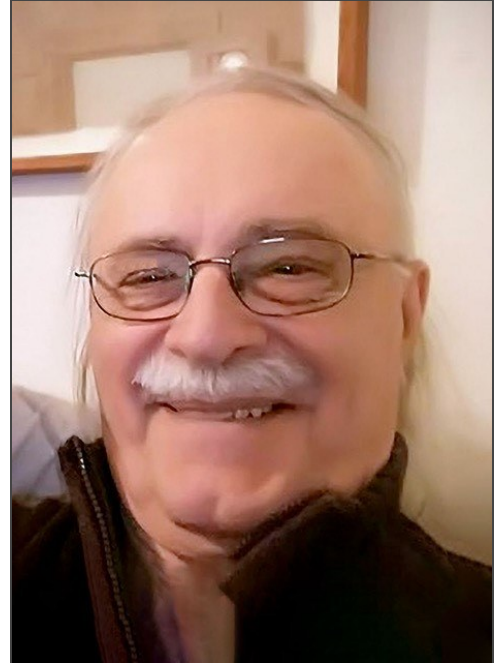
