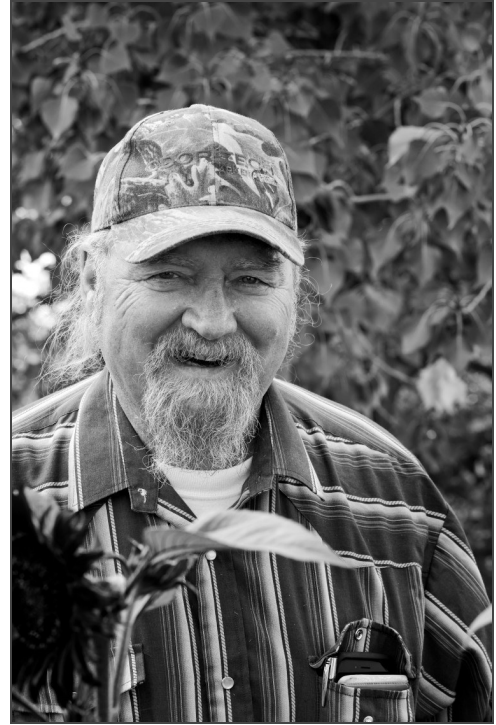


# Gerald Wayne Heisler
