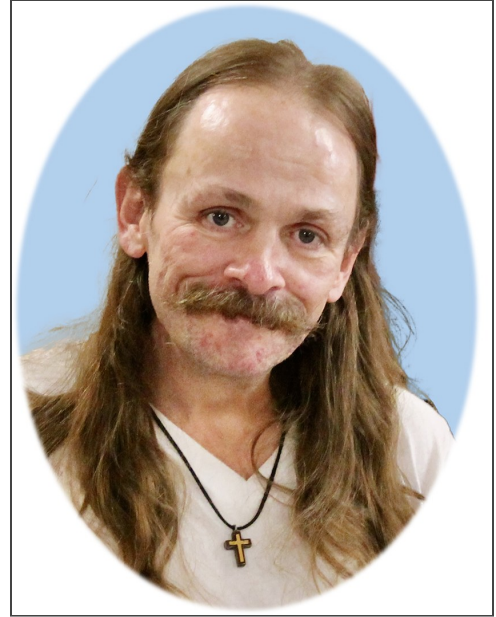


# Patrick Joseph Henry
