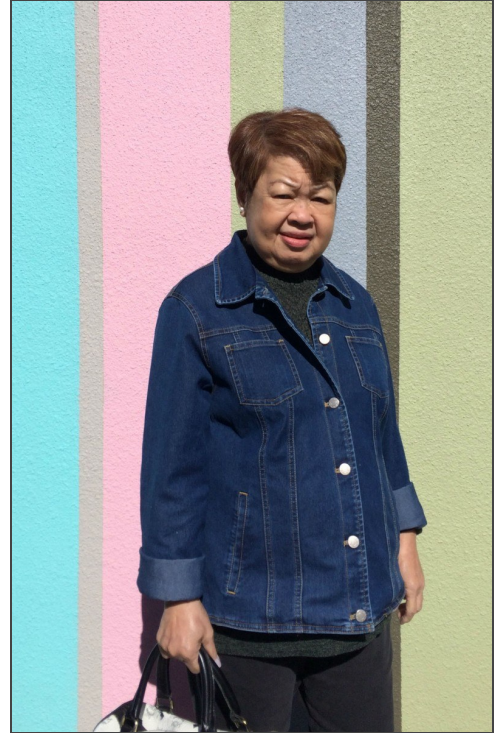


Esterlita “Ester” Hernandez
