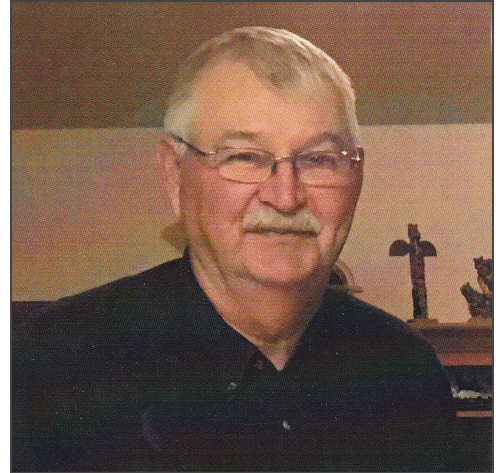


Frederick Lorne Hill
