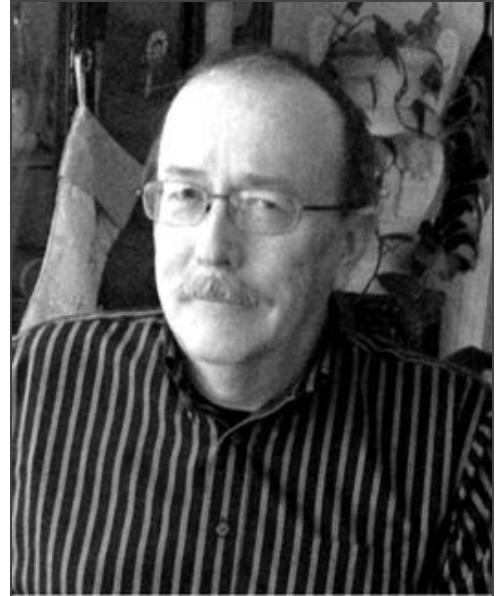
HILL, Norman Wilfred
