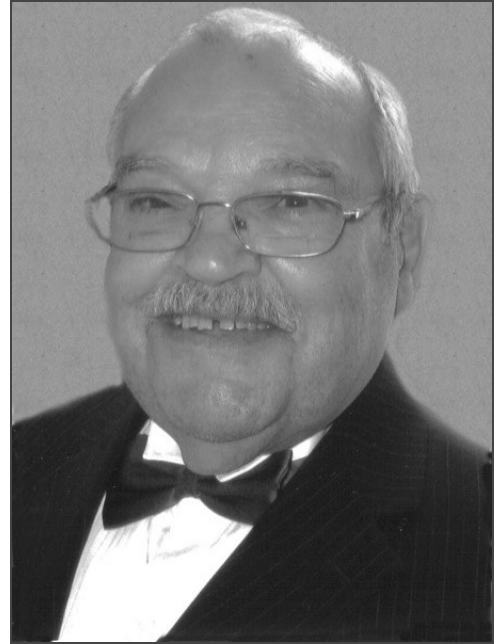


Clifford Grant Hoath
