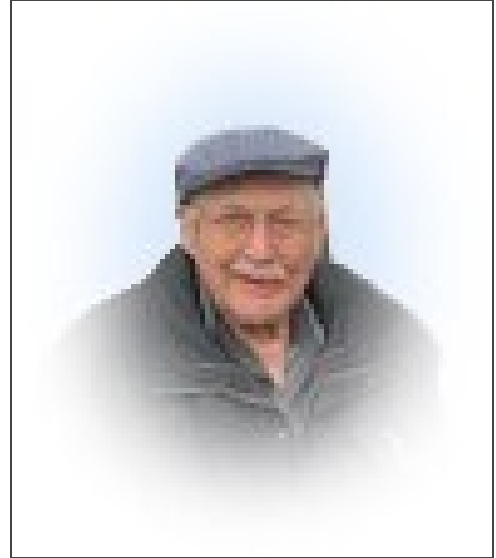


Delaware Richard Hobby
