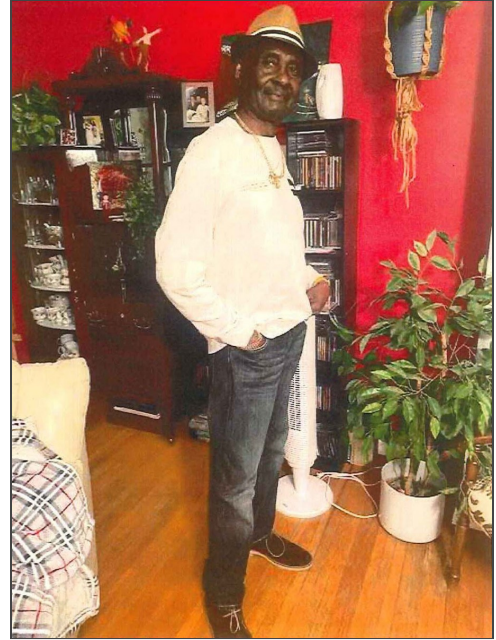


# Cecil Hodge (Sauce)
