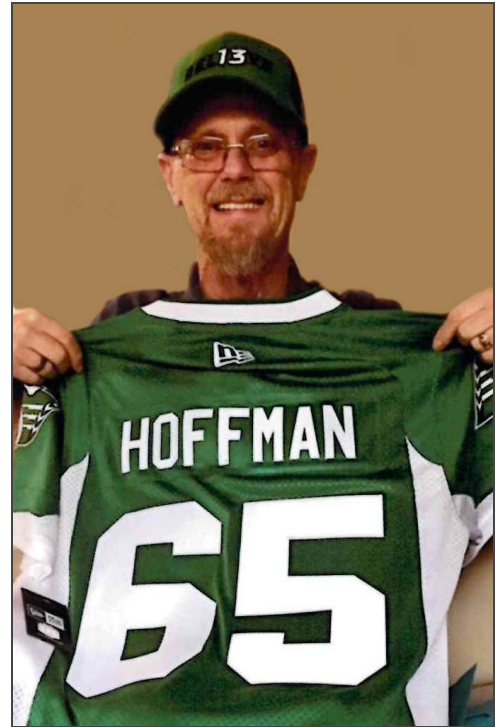


# Donald E. A. Hoffman
