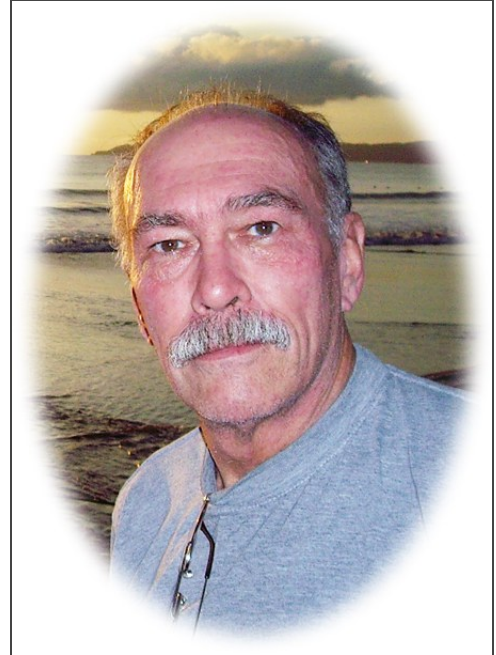


# Stephen William Andrew Holmes
