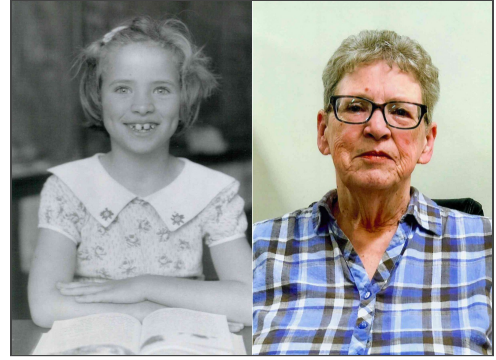


Charlene Horaska
