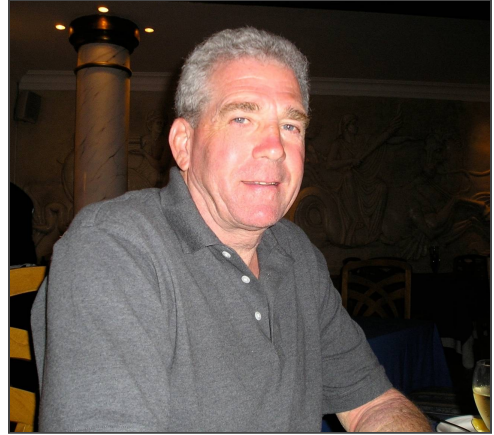


David Houle
