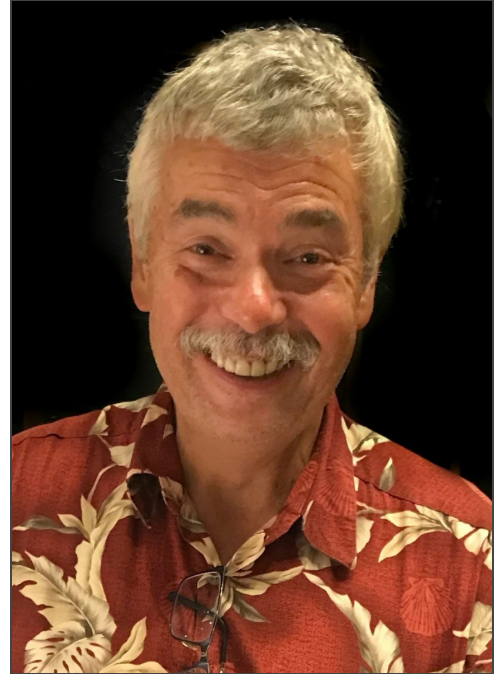


# George Alfred Howe
