known for his famous smile and could always be found at Walmart or McDonalds

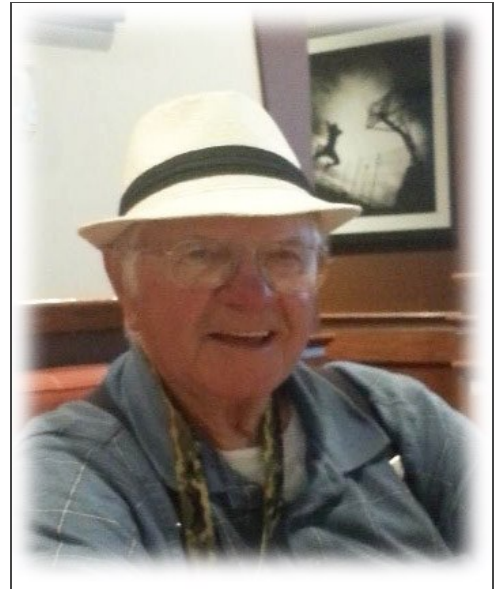
every day. During the summer months, Spud spent his days at the golf course.
