

Murray Dale Hubick

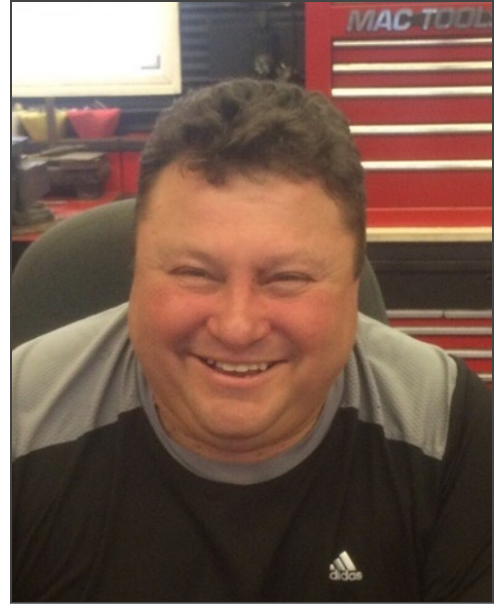
