Left to mourn him are his Regina family - life partner Shelly Brown; his step daughters

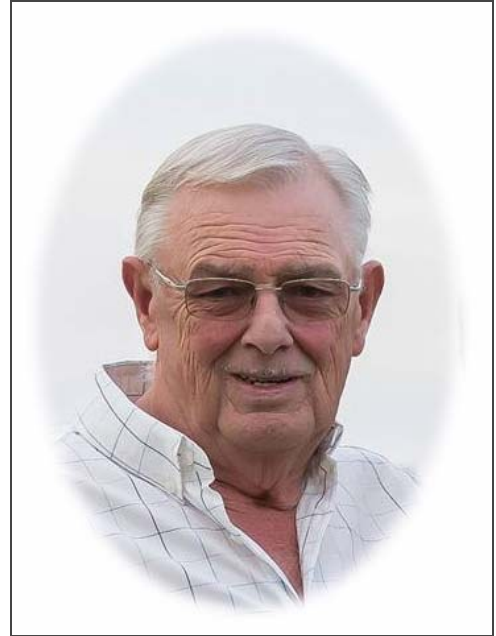
