

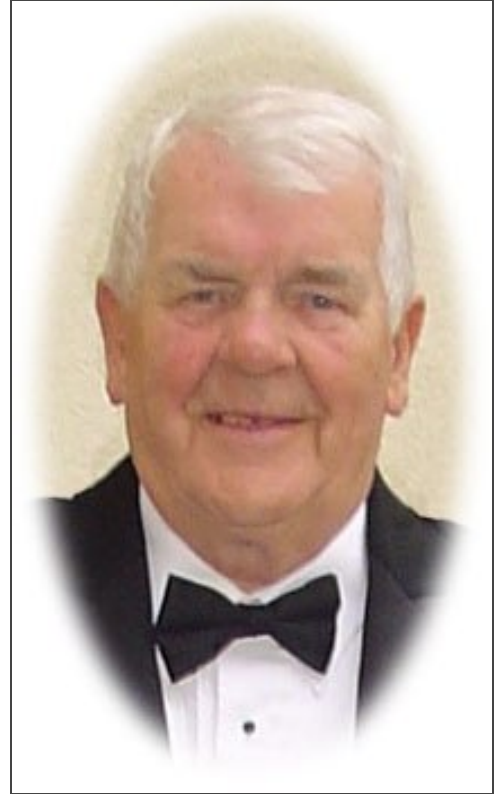
Walter "Wally" Millar Hunter
