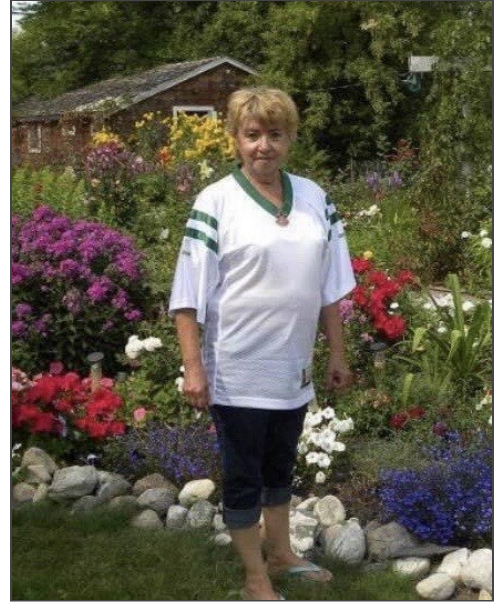


Patricia Belle Husband
