

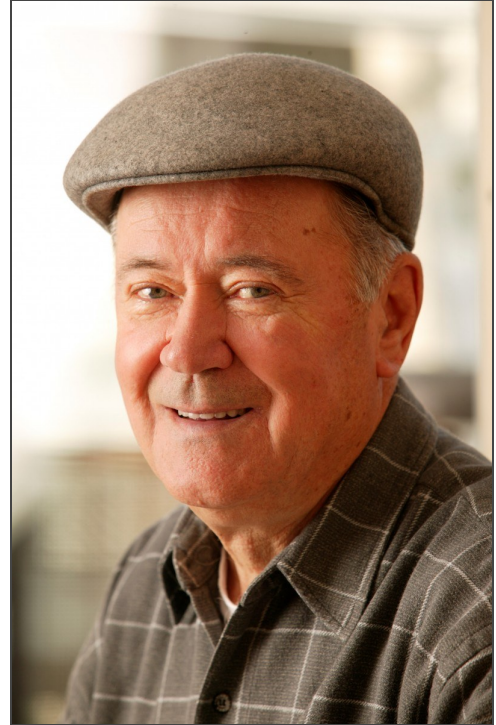
# Henry Huszar
