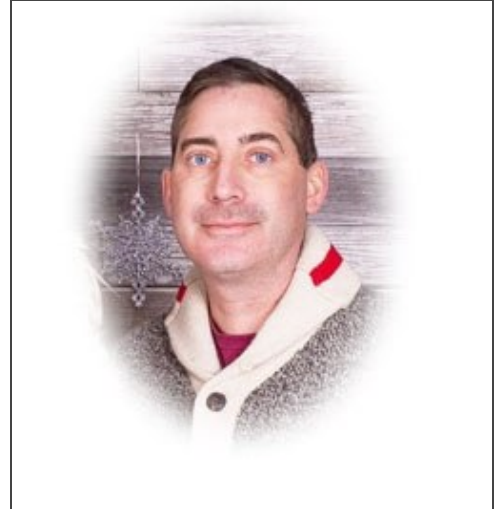
It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Troy Irvine on Wednesday, April 17, 2019 at the age of 38. He was born in

His energy and quiet understanding disposition helped mentor many young people to pursue an active productive lifestyle. His skills at this time were in active sports, counselling and technology.
