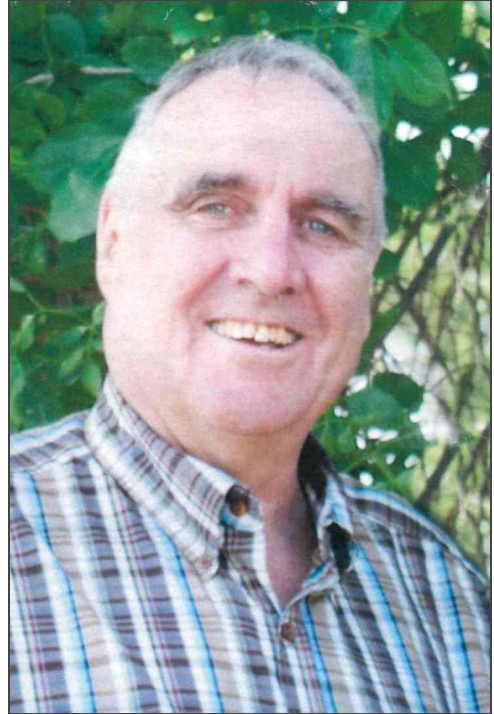


Mervin William Jackson
