We are saddened to announce the sudden passing of Lesli Jolly in the Pasqua Hospital, Regina, Saskatchewan on May 16, 2022 after fighting an aggressive cancer diagnosis.



Lesli is survived by her sister Debra Hamilton (Hugh Fisher) of Kingston, Ontario; her nephews Jordan Hamilton (Deborah) of Calgary, Alberta and Aaron Hamilton (Rain) of Perth, Ontario; and the many cousins she regularly corresponded with.
