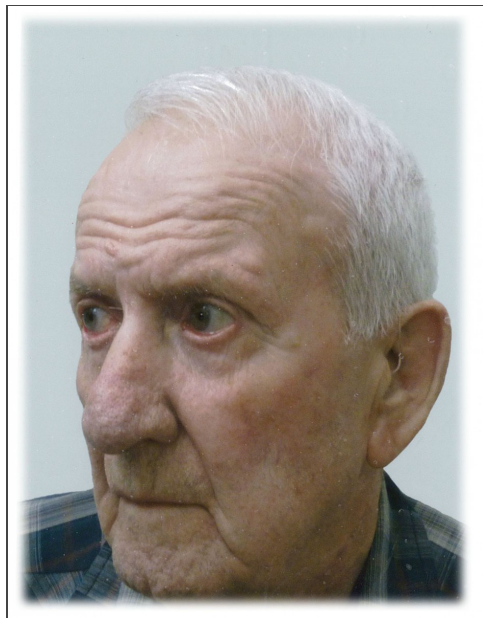


David "Doc" Robert Jones
