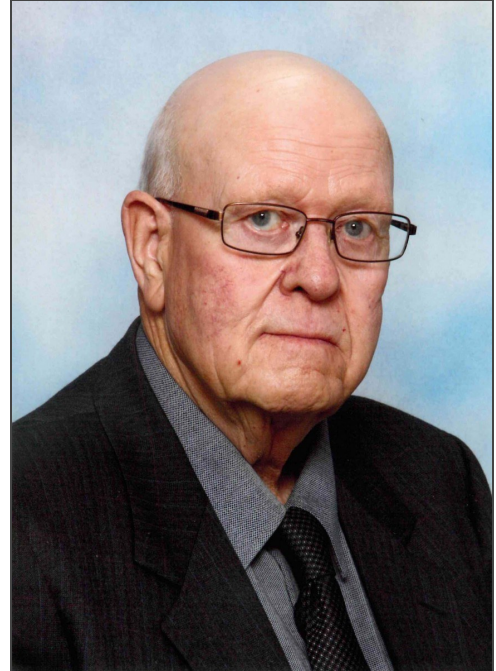


# Kyle Josvanger
