Walter Keim, longtime resident of the Carstairs community passed away on Wednesday, November 2, 2011 at the age of 85 years.

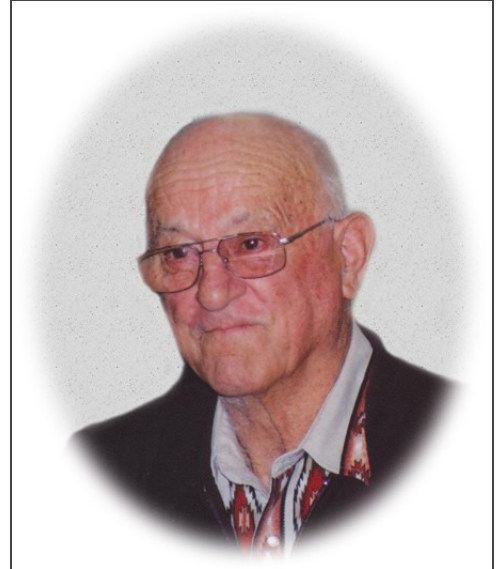
Walter is lovingly remembered by his family, wife Violet of 65 years; children Larry (Linda), Ron (Diane), Donna (Earl) and Sid;
