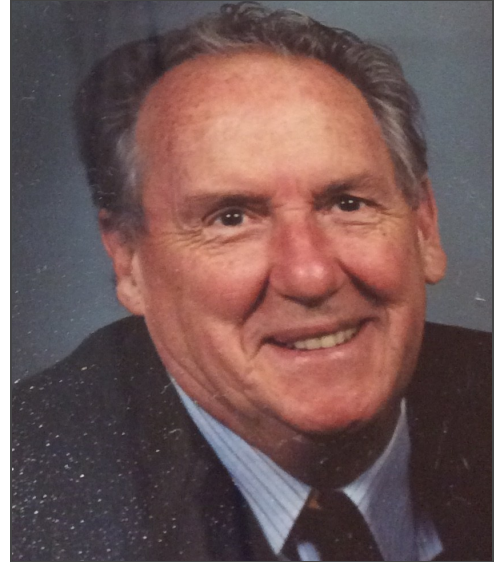


Frank Kenna
