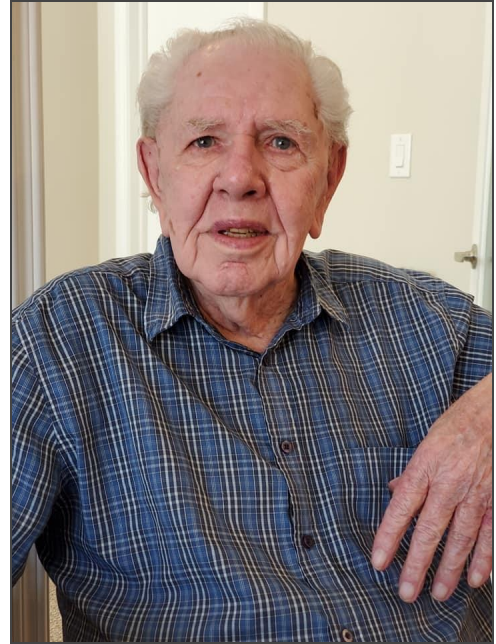


Hugh Kennedy
