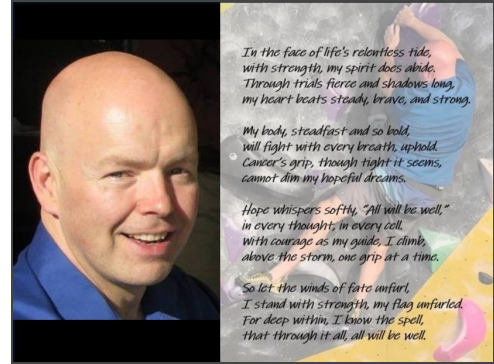


Kevin Roosdahl
