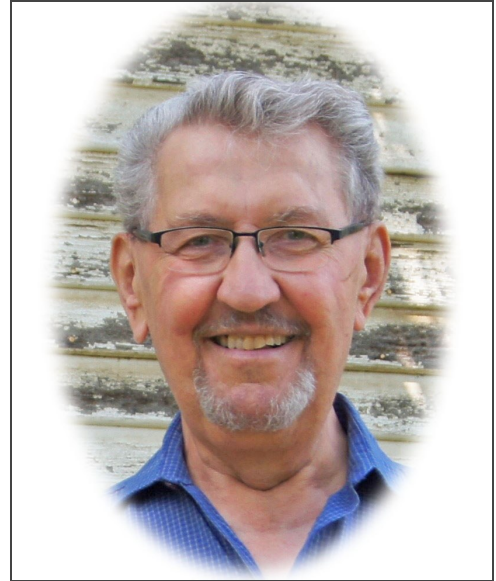


Norman Kirk
