Marc dedicated his life to Jesus at age 6 and studied his King James Bible to learn and grow in his faith with God.

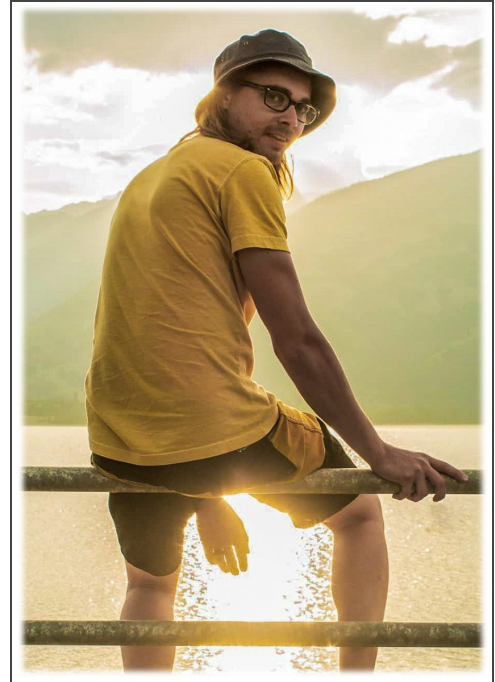
