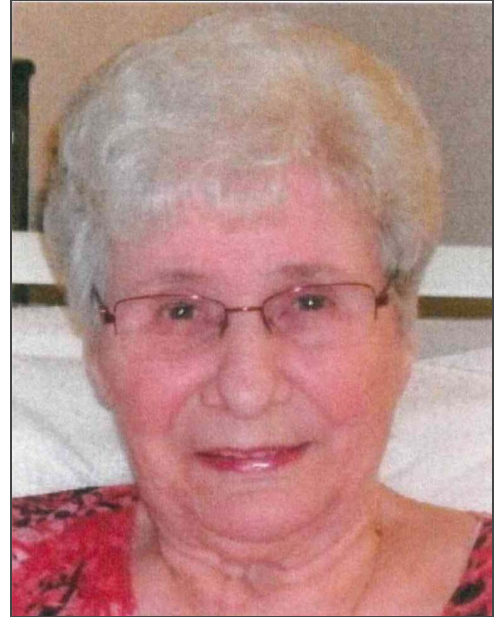


Doris Klein
