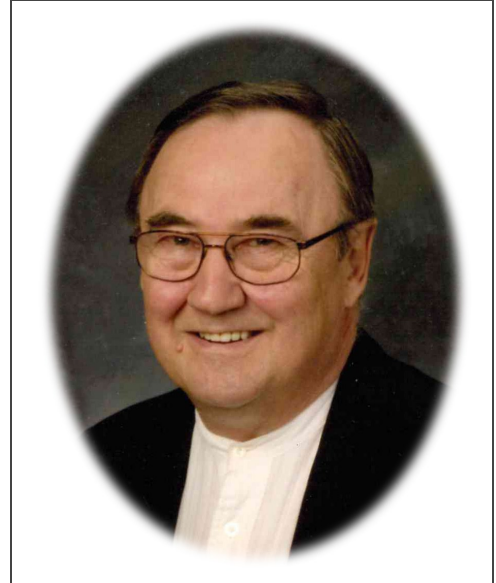


Ed Koshman
