Edna loved to spend time at the family cottage at Manitou. There, she loved to swim at the spa and, as always, visit and share meals with family and friends. She also really enjoyed Sunday drives and trips to BC to visit family.

Edna's huge love of family and her kind generosity warmed the hearts of many. Her granddaughter, Katherine, was very important to Edna and she was so pleased, almost tickled, in her brief encounters with her great grandson, Erick. Edna is remembered by many as having been a kind and gentle person. Even in Edna's last days, many of the staff from 4West at Regina Pioneer Village stopped by with a greeting and kind word for her. While in her wan condition, Edna's smile shone in return to these visitors and all her helpers.
