Levern Krenzler, only child of Bernhart and Otilia Krenzler, was born in Leola, South Dakota, on October 27, 1924. He died in Calgary at the age of 90 years on Tuesday, January 13, 2015. Levern and his parents immigrated to Canada when he was 4 years old and they farmed in the Acme area of Alberta. He attended high school in Swalwell, then went on to Canadian Union College (now Burman University) in Lacombe.
