Larry was diagnosed with MS and eventually confined to a wheelchair, but he always had a positive outlook on life.

When visiting with Larry, you could expect to get wisdom or advice. He enjoyed telling jokes and stories, often with a moral or lesson at the end. Larry believed that you should not be susceptible to the negative influences of other people. Another quote he would often say was "It's not your aptitude, it's your attitude that determines your altitude." During one of the last visits when in hospice care Larry said "I'm off to sail amongst the stars" - he was a sailor to the core and with that

we wish him well on his final voyage.

"Here he lies where he longed to be; home is the sailor, home from the sea."

"We are all just visitors to this time, this place. We are just passing through. Our purpose here is to learn, to grow, to love... And then we return home"
