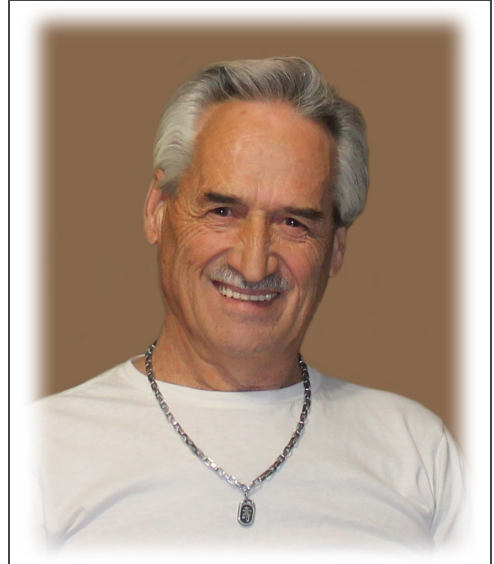


Malcolm Kunitz
