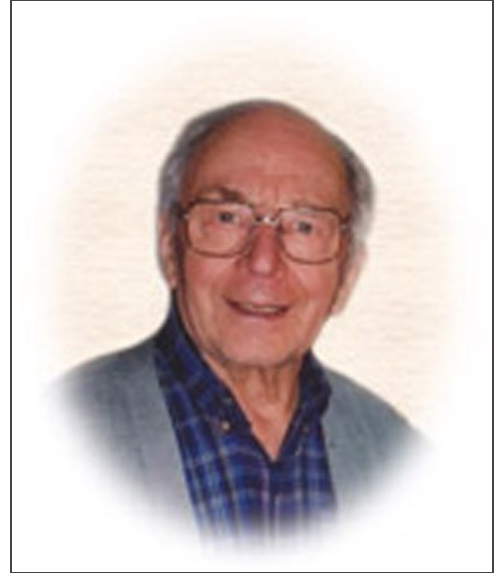


Uno (Joel) Kuttainen
