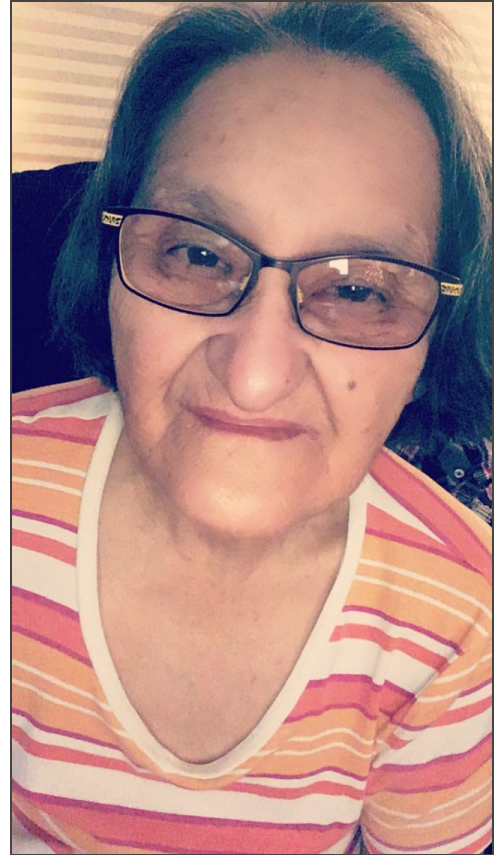


Rosalie "Rose" Lagimodiere (nee Pelletier)
