

# Garry LaMontagne

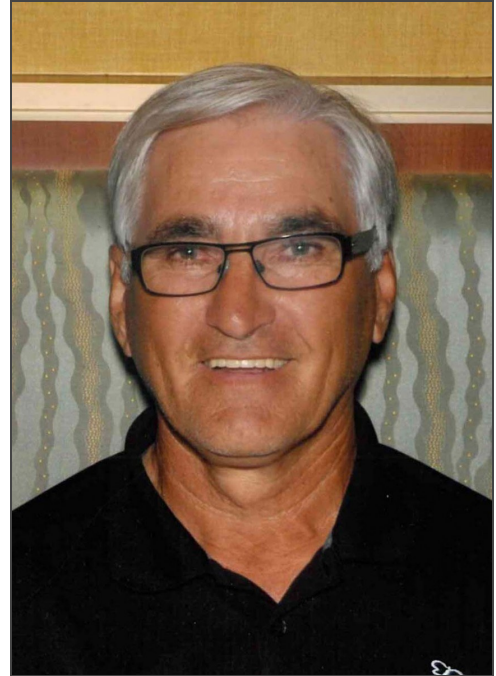
