Lancaster, when he was serving in the Canadian army in England. She was married in Red Deer, Alberta in 1948. Joyce and Rob spent the following years in Guelph, Nelson, where their four children were born, Abbotsford and Surrey BC and finally in Fort Macleod, AB, where they lived for many years. After Rob passed away in 1982, Joyce moved to Calgary.

Joyce is survived by her children, Jill (Brian) McColl, Richard (Nancy) and Duncan (Vikki); and by son-in-law, Thomas Erdman (Betty).
