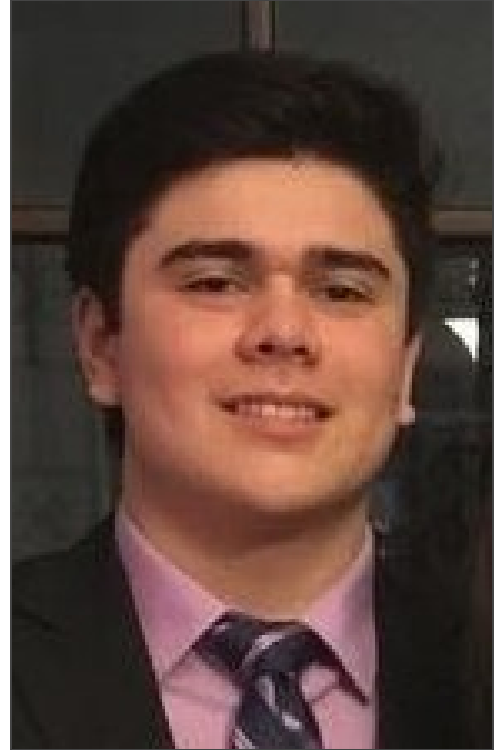


Miguel Lucas Antoan Lane
